1. Abstract

This document contains instructions and formatting guidelines for authors submitting the camera ready version of their posters accepted to SYSTOR 2015.

The poster will be published as a one page length extended abstract by the ACM digital library. The authors will retain the copyright for the publication, but will be required to sign a P&R form allowing ACM to publish the extended abstract in ACM digital library.

- **Page limit:** extended abstracts may be **at most** 1 page long, including references.
- **Formatting:**
 - Please use this latex template for the camera ready version.
 - The template complies with the SYSTOR typesetting guidelines.
 - Do NOT include page numbers in the final manuscript.
 - Make sure all fonts are embedded in the resulting PDF file.
 - Make sure to include the names of all authors along with their affiliation and email ID.
 - Please refer to the sample author block in this document.
- **Citations:** here are some example citations (Lamport 1994; Lastname1 et al. 2000; Lastname1 and Lastname2 2001).
- **Submission Instructions:**
 - Authors will be individually contacted by ACM with instructions on submitting the rights management form.
 - Submit the finalized PDF of your paper labeled as follows:

with the conference name and the number of your submission in the subject line (e.g., SYSTOR15 - # - Camera Ready).

2. Section
